

# **Build a Snowman**

Grades: K-5 [YouTube]

# **EQUIPMENT**

- Any available equipment (hula hoops, jump ropes, bean bags, noodles, etc.)
- Snowman Dice Chart

## **SET-UP**

- Group students into teams of 4-6.
- Spread groups around the perimeter with a copy of the Snowman Dice Chart.
- Place equipment in the center of the playing area.

#### **OBJECTIVE**

• To collect enough equipment to build a fun and creative snowman.

# **DESCRIPTION**

- Today's challenge is to build the most epic and creative snowman ever!
- On the start signal, 1 member of each group will roll a 6-sided die. Next, everyone in the group completes the task list on the Snowman Dice Chart. After that, the student who rolled will collect one piece of equipment.
- Take turns rolling the 6-sided die and collecting equipment until you have between 10-20 items (or until you hear the stop signal).
- Work cooperatively to build a snowman!

### NOTES FOR TEACHER

• There is a similar variation of this activity in Active Classrooms. Adapt this lesson into a version that works best for you and your instructional environment.

## **PE2020 STRATEGIES**

- Physically Distant: Students can work individually or in partners while maintaining safe physical distancing.
- At Home: Challenge students to play this activity using items they have available (ex. laundry basket, tissue box, socks, paper plates, towels, etc.).
